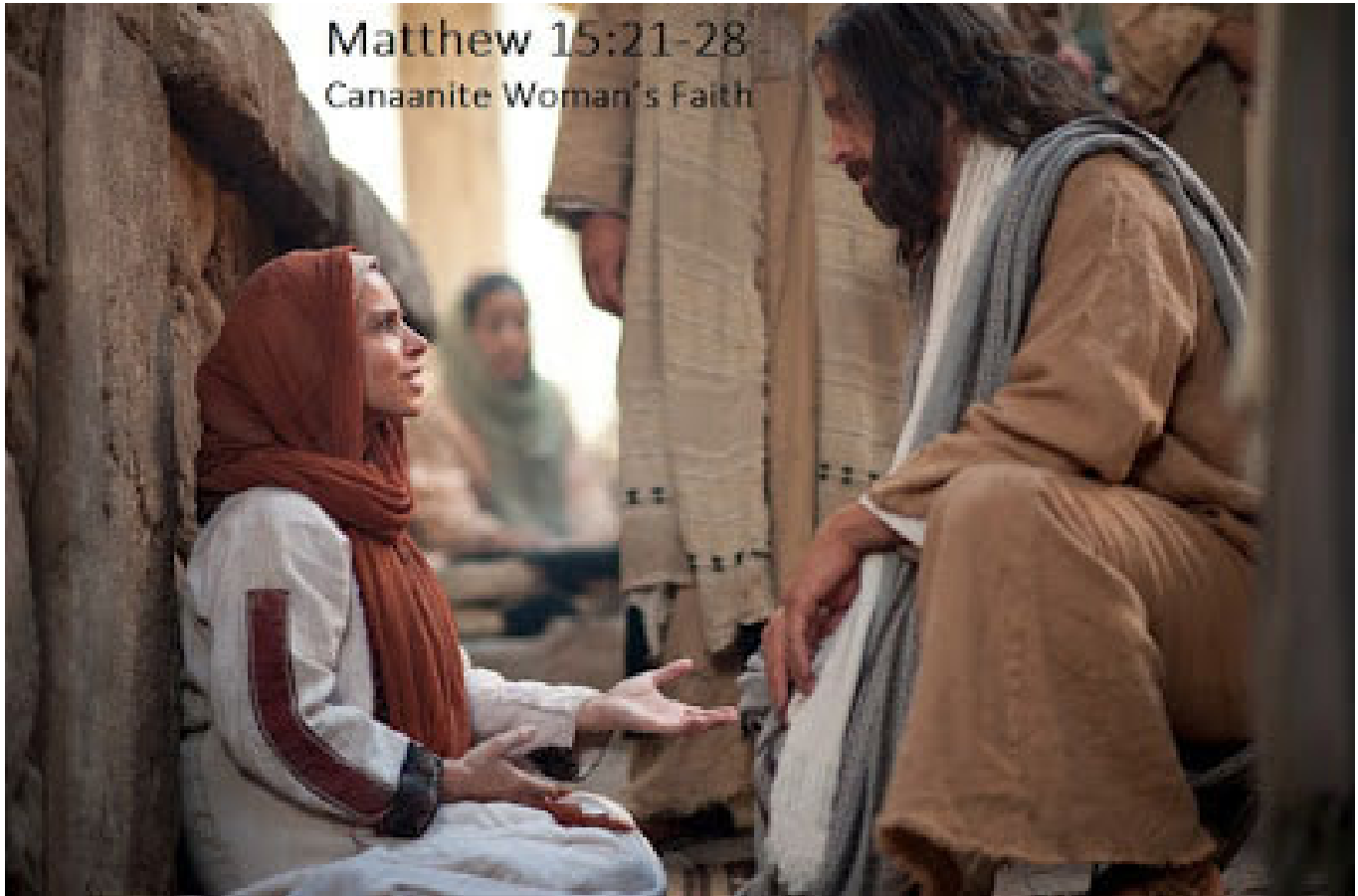

Reaching Beyond The Wall

There is a great controversy in our country today about allowing "foreigners" legal or illegal into our country. Some have even proposed a wall to keep them out.

There was controversy about "foreigners" in Jesus' time as well. The Jewish people believed they were the chosen people of God and that those who were "far off" meaning foreigners were outside of God's Mercy. Jesus reflects the attitude of the time when he said he was sent "Only to the lost sheep of the home of Israel".

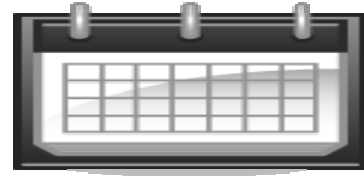
The woman's faith overcomes Jesus reluctance to heal her daughter. He exclaims how great the woman's faith is and heals her daughter. Paul too reflects this belief when he says he is the apostle to the "Gentiles", all those who were not Jewish, and that God's Mercy is upon all.

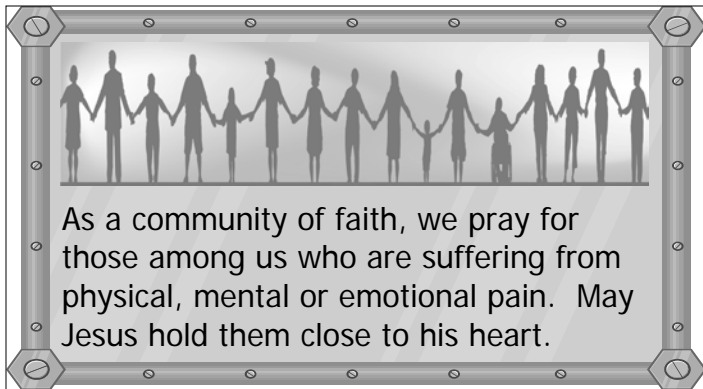
