Training and Certification Workshops

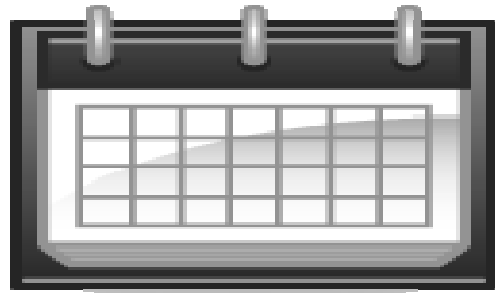
