"I go now to prepare a place for you so that where I am you too shall also be."

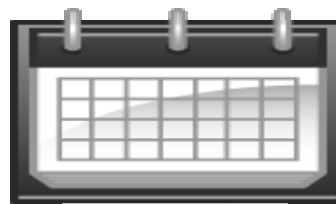
