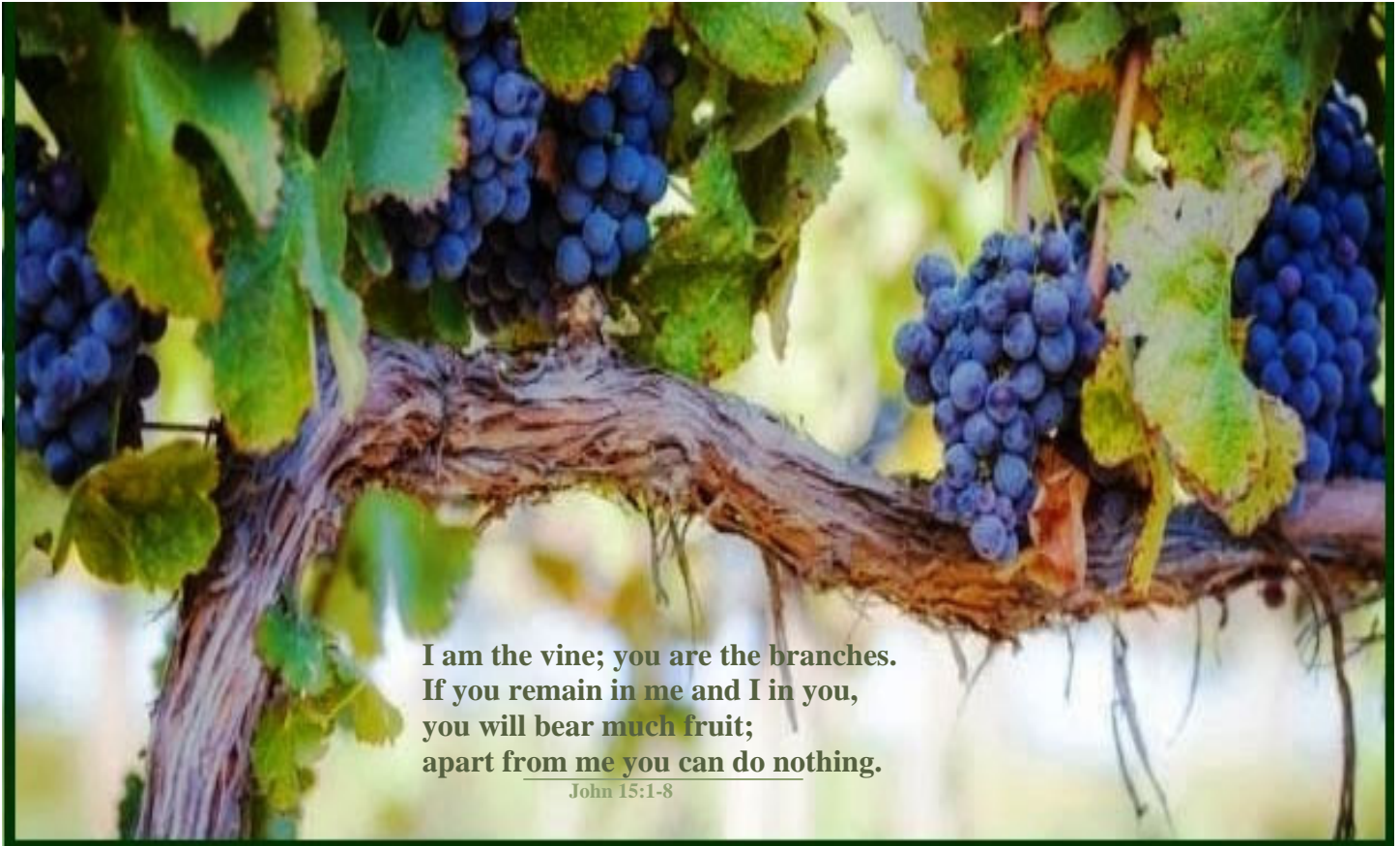

When I was growing up in Vallejo, California, my Dad decided that we should grow some grapes in our backyard. Being so close to the Napa Valley, he thought they would do great in Vallejo.

There was only one problem, the climate in Vallejo is very different than the Napa Valley. It is much cooler and wetter in Vallejo than a few miles north in Napa.
