The Holy Trinity

There are three great religions that believe in the oneness of God. These are the Jewish, Christian, and Islamic faiths.

Judaism honors Moses and Elijah as the great prophets of the one God; Islam honors Mohammad as the prophet of the one God. Christianity honors Jesus not only as its great prophet but as Son of God. It also honors the Spirit of Jesus as God. This makes Christianity unique in our understanding of the one God as a Holy Trinity.

The Trinity really highlights the work of God. We understand God as Creator (Father), Savior (Son) and sanctifier (Holy Spirit) without compromising the oneness of God. The Trinity reveals to us how God works in our lives.

We are Baptized in the Name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit when we enter the family of the Church. It emphasizes that our life comes from God, that we are saved by the death and resurrection of Jesus, and that we are called to be his witnesses in the world by the power of his Spirit.

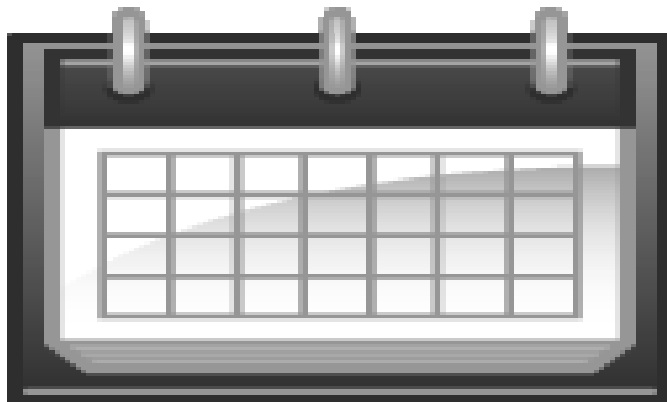
So today, we honor the oneness of God, and we reflect on God's presence and work in our daily lives.

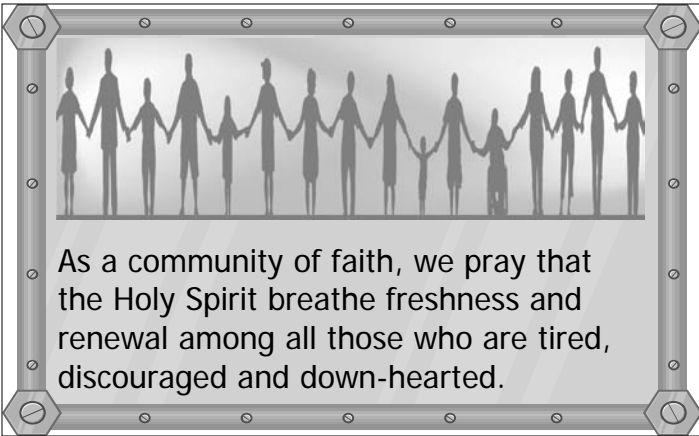
