Dear Parishioners,

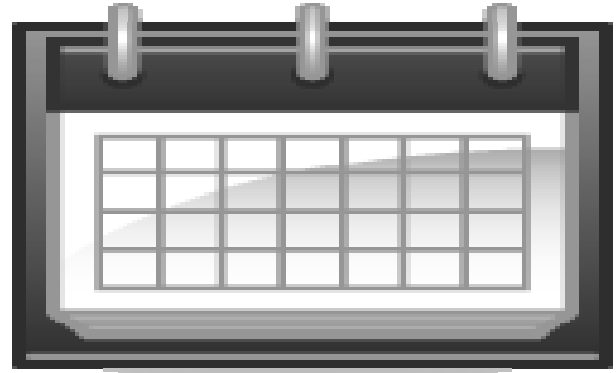
One of the songs we sing every so often is "Christ Be Our Light." Our Sisters and Associates sang it recently when we celebrated the jubilees of all our Sisters – 50 years for the one who entered with me and myself, as well as 60, 65 and 70 year women! The second verse says, "Longing for peace, our world is troubled, longing for hope, many despair. Your word alone has power to save us. Make us your living voice."

How can we do this when we're among those experiencing the stresses of this time in our country? Psychologists can offer us some help; here's a summary of their suggestions. Set time limits for the amount of disturbing information you take in and don't listen to it or read it first thing in the morning or the last thing at night. Reading something in print will often include local stories with less emotional content. Be sure you find some positive stories which highlight acts of bravery or compassion to combat feelings of fear and pessimism. Disconnect when you need to. If you can't help the kids you're concerned about in a hands-on way, help other kids. And for us, as people of faith and hope, continue to pray for everyone involved in situations which concern us. God has promised to be with us and God is faithful.

If you've never volunteered at St. Anthony's Dining Room, it is an experience you won't easily forget. If you are available on Friday, August 10, please consider coming! We'll leave from inside the rectory at 8:30 am and return at 2:30 pm. The shift includes serving meals to families and handicapped folks; giving the able-bodied guests a second meal; and clearing and wiping the tables. Service hours gladly given! 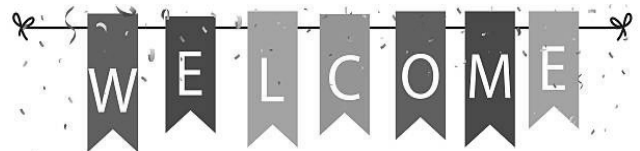
