Dear Parishioners,
 No doubt we've noticed the leaves on the trees changing colors with the arrival of autumn. Since anyone with little ones knows that Wednesday is Halloween, Thursday must be All Saints Day and Friday, All Souls Day. The Church recognizes many holy men and women as official saints because their lives so closely reflect the love and compassion of Jesus. Mother Teresa's faith and ministry to the dying was recently acknowledged as was Archbishop Oscar Romero's martyrdom because of his speaking out against the oppression of the poor in El Salvador. The following day we honor those who've died and pray for them in case they haven't yet made their way into God's loving arms in heaven. Some of them, often our relatives or close friends, are surely saints, though not officially, because of their own loving, compassionate lives.

Though we may rarely reflect on it, we are all called to live out the same values Jesus did and therefore, to become saints! It's not a complicated directive, though it surely is not easy. We hear what we should be trying to do every day in all our relationships in next weekend's gospel. To a scribe's question, which is the first of all the commandments, Jesus answers, *"You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength."* The second is this: *"You shall love your neighbor as yourself."*

As we pray for those who died in the past year (whose names surround us in this church) or those whose names are on the altar during this month of November, we make them present again by our memories of their goodness and our prayers for them. May we honor them by asking for their guidance to help us in living out the values which we learned from them.

May God give us, our families, our country and our world peace.
