



- Records Baptisms and Weddings in books in a safe.
- Maintains and orders office supplies, Mass Intention books & Daily Mass Records.
- Performs secretarial work for designated staff.
- Covers for the secretary when on vacation.
- Records Vanco donations (monthly) into Quick Books.
- Works with the Accountant regarding monthly print-outs of bank statements.
- Notify the Web Master of website changes/ additions/deletions (i.e., Weekly Sunday Deposits, Christmas and Easter schedules, phone numbers, etc).
