

# Are you thinking of becoming a Catholic?


The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a process for adults who wish to join the Catholic Church or become fully initiated as a Catholic. The Sacraments of Initiation are: Baptism or Profession of Faith (for those already baptized in another faith tradition), Confirmation and Holy Communion. Through weekly meetings and the shared experience of special liturgies, candidates examine and deepen their faith lives while understanding the teachings of the Catholic Church.
