Dear Friends,

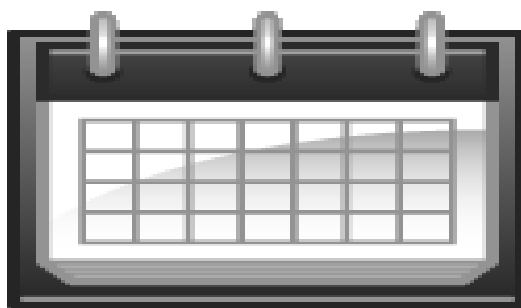
Sitting here on Gene's deck, in the warmth of the July sun, sipping Mango tea, I think about the Mercy of our God. Today we hear from the Book of Wisdom: ***"There is no god besides you who have the care of all....But though you are master of might, you judge with clemency, and with much leniency you govern us...And you taught your people, by these deeds, that those who are just must be kind."***

In the Responsorial Psalm, David prays: ***"You, O Lord, are a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in kindness and fidelity."*** Our God is not just a loving merciful God – Our God **is** Mercy! Our God **is** Love! His mercy and His love are melded together; we can't have one without the other. We don't have to work to obtain God's mercy and love. All we have to do is to sit quietly and ask Him for it. Then we open our hearts to receive it. His mercy and love enter into us and fill us. The only thing God asks is that we don't just keep it for ourselves; but that we let it flow through us to our sisters and brothers by forgiving them as He forgives us; by helping them when they need us.

I awoke a few mornings ago to the sound of rushing water. I discovered that my garden hose had split and water was gushing out, boring a deep hole into my lawn. There was no possible way I could reach the faucet to turn off the water. My daughter Shirley and her husband Ken (who are always there for me when I need them) were away on vacation. It was not yet 6:00AM. Standing at my window, I prayed aloud: "O Jesus, who can I call at this early hour?" The moment these words were spoken, I saw my good neighbor Vicky crossing the street. When she went into her house, I phoned her. Without hesitation, Vicky hurried over and, wading through ankle-deep mud, turned off the faucet. Vicky, having received Jesus' mercy, lets His mercy flow through her to everyone who needs her. That morning, I surely did need her. "Thank you, Jesus, and thank you, Vicky."
