Pastor's Comments:

Old Business:

A) The Brochure is ready, and will be printed in June to be ready for the fall.

B) The school supply list will be passed out and collected before the end of the year.

C) Art in Action made the presentation to the faculty on April 3rd. A number of issues remain:

- The program is not geared for classes of 35 students, so they would have to be divided into two groups,
- the veteran teachers commented that they still had kits similar to the Art in Actions from a similar program 6-7 years ago, and the cost is an issue.
- It was also noted that DeYoung Museum has some free materials that could be used in similar fashion.

At this time, the school will not pursue this program.

D) Kidstock Director Jane Ann Sullivan is to meet with Yvonne on May 15 to further discuss the possibility of adding Kidstock as a program in the fall. This program would incorporate drama, music, and dance to each class. Additionally, they would put on 3 productions a year, most likely 2 for the middle school and 1 for the K-5 kids.

New Business

A) There are two openings for the board and the vote will be held in May. Those interested need to submit their names by May 12, and the vote is after each mass the week of May 20-21

B) Jim Shick presented information from two pre-school teachers interested in opening a St. Robert pre-school. The board determined this is not an option at this time for the following reasons

- space on the school grounds,
- space in the kindergarten the following year,
- the fact that it must be maintained by the parish, not the school,
- the amount of regulation involved and how it would impact the current programs.

C) Rusty is working on replacing the awning over the library

D) Bart Murphy is looking into the padding for the basketball poles.
